

Introduction to Socially Engaged Art Practices

'Socially engaged art practices', 'creative recovery' and 'arts and health' are increasingly becoming part of our contemporary art vocabulary. The growth in these types of practices raises important questions about how we share knowledge and build a community of practice.

This two-day learning event is for artists who are interest in learning about and practicing in ways that are 'socially engaged'. Using a mix of presentations, case studies, reading material and group activities, this weekend will give participants a practical, theoretical and ethical background in socially engaged practices.

Led by Vic McEwan, Sarah McEwan and Sarah Penicka-Smith with guest speakers <u>Karenza Ebejer</u> and <u>Mitch King</u>, this weekend workshop will provide opportunities to discuss and explore practice, with the aim of giving participants confidence to apply their socially engaged learnings within their own communities and projects.

*Free for healthcare card holders and up to four regional NSW artists who live in an area with a RADO. These artists are also eligible for a \$200 travel bursary that will be paid to them on the first day of the workshop.

Access in the Leda Business Centre, Rosebery

The Leda Business Centre has three entrances. The entrance on Harcourt Pde has nine stairs.
